



Pathway 2 Academic Program List

The following academic programs purport to meet the following graduation criteria specified by IBLCE:

- At least one year in length and is offered by an accredited college or university;
- Require students to complete the General Education in the Health Sciences requirement either before admission or concurrently with the other required studies and clinical experience;
- Include both the classroom instruction and the clinical experience requirements in the curriculum;
- Have recertified IBCLCs as the program director and primary faculty members;
- Provide a minimum of 90 hours of instruction in human lactation and breastfeeding; and
- Offer provisions for the student to obtain a minimum of 300 hours of lactation specific clinical experience that is directly supervised by currently certified IBCLCs.

This list is provided for the convenience of individuals interested in following Pathway 2. IBLCE has not extensively evaluated these academic programs and, therefore, does not recommend or endorse these academic programs in human lactation and breastfeeding.
