



Recognized Mother Support Counselor Organizations

The term “mother support counselor” is used by IBLCE to identify individuals who obtain their lactation care experience in one of the following ways:

- Volunteer, accredited mother-to-mother breastfeeding support counselors such as La Leche League Leaders and Australian Breastfeeding Association Counselors
- Paid or volunteer mother support counselors who work within a health care delivery organization such as a hospital, birth center or community clinic
